Our next up and coming event is our **Parent Consultations**. For this, we will be meeting you online to discuss your child's progress. As normal, you will be able to book up for slot on e-schools. If you have mislaid your login, please contact the school office. Each slot will be a 10 minute appointment as normal.



For the consultations, we just ask that you are available and logged into your child's 'Teams' account at your allotted time. We will be sending out Teams logins separately. Our teachers will then Teams call you (it is just a bit like a Facetime call), and you will answer on your device. It should be as simple as that!!!

If you have not used this before or are unsure, please do ask the school for some help and we will do our best to assist. Teams communicates using your device camera and microphone, but please do not feel that you must have the camera on. We will understand if you wish to keep it off. Please also consider whether you have your child with you or not and let us know when you join the meeting whether they are in the meeting. We would not give a different message about them, but we may frame it differently if younger ears are listening in. Likewise, if you have any sensitive or delicate questions to ask us, please be mindful of whether your child will be listening in.
