What have we raised and how is the money being spent so far?

Last term we held 3 main events, the Sweet Cone Sale, our two fantastic Glow Discos and our Christmas Festivities (which included the Christmas Fayre, Christmas Tree Sales, Christmas Jumper Exchange and the Xmas4Schools artwork). In total we raised approximately £3550. So far, with this money we have

1. Subsidised the pantomime to vastly bring the cost down per pupil.
2. Funded the visit of Michael Loader, who was a story telling author who did a lovely workshop with KS1 children (and their maxi-mates in Year 6)
3. Agreed to fund the Year 6 Life Skills Course and contribute towards their leavers celebrations.
4. Contributed towards the specialist delivery of the Pianola which was a rare instrument gifted to the school in September.
